

Well Child Check & Immunization Schedule

0-2
years

At every well child visit we:

- ✓ Check your child's growth (height/length & weight), vision and hearing
- ✓ Ask important screening and development questions and screen for Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)
- ✓ Share what you can expect for your child's age group and how to keep your child healthy

Other things to know:

- ✓ This appointment is a great time to ask questions and share concerns about your child's development.
- ✓ A yearly Flu Vaccine is recommended for everyone 6 months or older. Kids under 8 years may need a second dose of the Flu Vaccine.
